Transfer of Ownership

Under the Animal Pedigree Act, a person selling a horse as registered or eligible to be registered, must supply the buyer with the duly transferred certificate of registration within six months from the sale date. It is the legal responsibility of the seller to transfer ownership of a horse. Failure to supply the transferred certificate of registration can result in legal action being taken against the seller.

THE "ORIGINAL" CSHA REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE MUST ACCOMPANY THIS FORM IF THE HORSE IS REGISTERED. IF THE ORIGINAL IS NO LONGER AVAILABLE A STATUTORY DECLARATION MUST BE COMPLETED BY THE LAST OWNER ON FILE, NOTARIZED AND ACCOMPANY THIS FORM, ALONG WITH TRANSFER AND DUPLICATE CERTIFICATE FEE.
