Please attach any required additional forms as specified above. The exceptions are:

- (I) CERTIFICATES OF SERVICE – A certificate of service is NOT required
 - (a) if the service information has been officially recorded on the dam's certificate or,
 - (b) if another animal from the same birth has already been recorded or registered or,
 - (c) if the dam was bred by artificial insemination
- (II) ARTIFICIAL INSEMINATION (A.I) REPORT OF SERVICE – An A.I. Report of Service is NOT required
 - (a) if the service information has been officially recorded on the dam's certificate or,
 - (b) if another animal from the same birth has been recorded or registered.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1&2. Purebred means the animal conforms to the breed standard of its sire and dam who must both be purebreds of the same breed. Consult the current "Rules of Eligibility" for further information.
3. Animal's name: Name cannot be more than 30 letters and spaces. Names must begin with the breeder's registered herd name. If the breeder does not have a registered herd name, then NO herd name may be used. Names may not be changed after 30 days from the date of registration.
4. (I) Please report the animal's complete tattoo identification. All animals born in Canada except unrecorded grades, must be tattooed with:
 - a) the tattoo letters of the owner at birth (the tattoo letters must be registered with Canadian Livestock Records Corporation before tattooing the animal), and
 - b) a serial number not previously used by the owner at birth in tattooing goats born during the same year, and
 - c) the letter designating the year of birth. The correct year letters are "N" for 2003, "P" for 2004, "R" for 2005, "S" for 2006, "T" for 2007, "U" for 2008, "W" for 2009, "X" for 2010, "Y" for 2011, "Z" for 2012, "A" for 2013, "B" for 2014, "C" for 2015, "D" for 2016, "E" for 2017, "F" for 2018, "G" for 2019, "H" for 2020.
The letters "I", "O", "Q" and "V" are not used for the year letters.
 (II) The recommended tattooing method is as follows: RIGHT EAR OR TAIL WEB – tattoo letters of the owner at birth, LEFT EAR OR TAIL WEB – a serial number followed by the year letter.
 (III) All animals must be properly tattooed BEFORE they can be recorded or registered. Please remember that the right and left ears and tail webs are determined by standing behind the animal, facing the same direction as the animal is facing.
5. Sex: Indicate the sex of the animal you are registering.
6. "Polled" means born naturally hornless (born without horns). The other choice is animals born with horns, whether they still have the horns or have been disbudded (removed before starting to grow or dehorned (removed after they had grown).
7. Breed type and colour standards are listed in the current "Rules of Eligibility". A non-conforming animal must have "Experimental status". IMPORTANT NOTE: Certificates for the animal being registered and all of the progeny may be cancelled if the application states that the animal conforms and is later found not to conform.
8. Colour & Markings: Be brief and accurate. For Toggenburgs, indicate the shade of brown (light, medium, dark) and whether or not the animal has the correct white or cream markings.
9. Ear Type: Note that in La Manchans, one kid in the birth can have gopher type ears and the other can have elf type ears.
10. Date of Birth: Must be EXACT.
11. Indicate total number of kids in the birth including those born dead. Indicate the number of each sex born.
12. Name of Sire: insert sire's name, breed and registration number.
13. Name of Dam: insert the dam's name, breed and registration number.
14. Insert the name of the breeder and his address in full, including the postal code. Please also indicate the breeder's I.D. NUMBER in the space allocated if known. The BREEDER of the animal is the owner or lessee of the dam on the date of conception. All transfers of ownership and lease agreements for recorded animals must be recorded in the files of the Canadian Livestock Records Corporation. Applications for transfer of ownership or for registration of leases are available on request.
15. Insert the name of the owner at birth and his address in full, including the postal code (leave blank if the same as the breeder). Please also indicate the owner at birth's I.D. NUMBER in the space allocated if known. The OWNER AT BIRTH of an animal is the owner or lessee of the dam on the date she gave birth to that animal. All animals born in Canada are first registered in the ownership of the owner at birth. The ownership may then be transferred, if necessary.
16. Insert the name of the importer and his address in full, including the postal code and the exact date on which the importer purchased the animal (leave blank if the animal was not imported). Please also indicate the importer's I.D. NUMBER in the space allocated, if known. The IMPORTER of an animal is the first owner of that animal who is a resident of Canada. All imported animals are first registered in the ownership of the importer. The ownership may then be transferred, if necessary. To avoid unnecessary delay, please consult the appropriate instruction form on imported animals (available on request) before submitting this application.
17. This must be the signature of the owner at birth, or if the animal was imported, the signature of the importer. Printed signatures are not acceptable. Partnership signatures require countersignatures.
18. If the owner at birth of kids did not own sire when the dam was bred, have the owner or lessee of the sire complete and sign the Certificate of Service or attach a separate Certificate of Service.
