

## CANADA FOX BREEDERS' ASSOCIATION

### Fox Definition.

All Standard foxes are classified as follows: Standard silver, standard white marked silver, standard platinum, standard pearl platinum, standard white marked pearl platinum and standard brown and their colour phase designated as, dark, medium, light or extra light.

### Descriptive Standards.

A Standard Silver Fox is a fox which has black or silver black characteristics with no white on the body nor with white above the knee or hock though it may have white in the vicinity of the sexual organs, a white star on the breast and/or white hairs or white spots caused by injury. (ABBREVIATION = **SS**)

A Standard White Marked Silver Fox is a fox which has black or silver black characteristics with distinct white markings on the face and neck areas and may have white markings also on the belly and legs above the knee or hock. The feet may be white. (ABBREVIATION = **SWMS**)

A Standard Platinum Fox is a fox with white markings, having underfur, guard fur and general appearance which blend throughout to give the desired Platinum shades. (ABBREVIATION = **SP**)

A Standard Pearl Platinum Fox is a fox which has bluish and/or bluish silver characteristics throughout. (ABBREVIATION = **SPP**)

A Standard White Marked Pearl Platinum Fox is a fox which has bluish and/or bluish silver characteristics with white markings on the face and neck areas and may have white markings also on the belly and legs above the knee or hock. The feet may be white. (ABBREVIATION = **SWMPP**)

An Alaskan Fox is the progeny of an Alaskan sire and dam and may have red or rusty hair in the ears or immediately in front of the ears.

A Standard Brown fox is a fox which has brown or bluish brown characteristics, with underfur, guard fur and general appearance blending throughout. (ABBREVIATION = **SB**)
